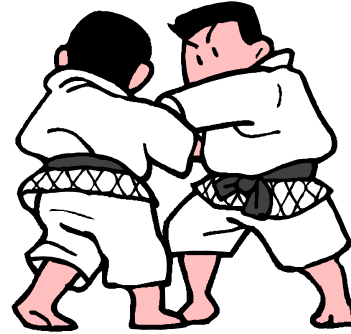
Be part of the 'Switch it Off' Campaign. Join schools across Warwickshire, Worcestershire and Coventry by Switching off your engines outside the school gates.

An idling engine produces 80% more pollution than when a vehicle is in motion. Emissions from car exhausts contain a range of toxic substances that can have a serious impact on children's health. 1 in 7 children suffer from asthma and medical evidence suggests that this is related to traffic fumes.

Tackling pollution and saving energy is one of the most important issues that face us today. If everyone makes a small effort, by simply turning off engines while waiting outside schools we can make a big difference and

improve the air quality in and around the school.

Switch it off- idling gets you nowhere!
